WHO ARE THE ACADEMIC STAFF?

- Approximately 12,733 academic professionals (10,316 FTE's) in higher education with responsibility for carrying out the instructional, research and public service mission of a major university system.

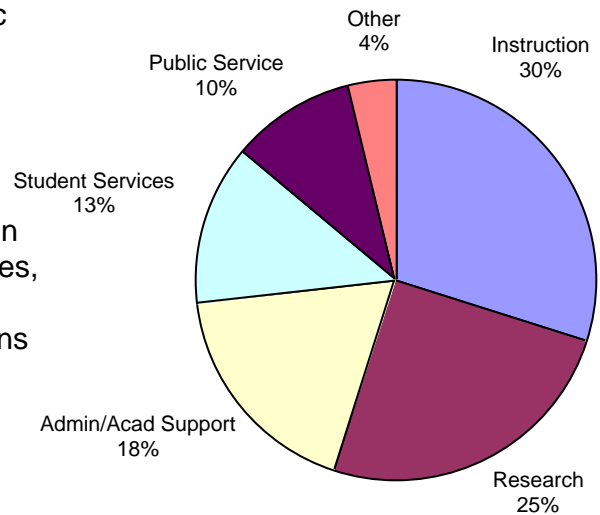
- The majority hold advanced degrees (M.D., Ph. D., J.D., Masters)

- Academic staff perform a wide range of functions in instruction, research, student services, library services, administration, clinical/health sciences, computer/information processing and communications

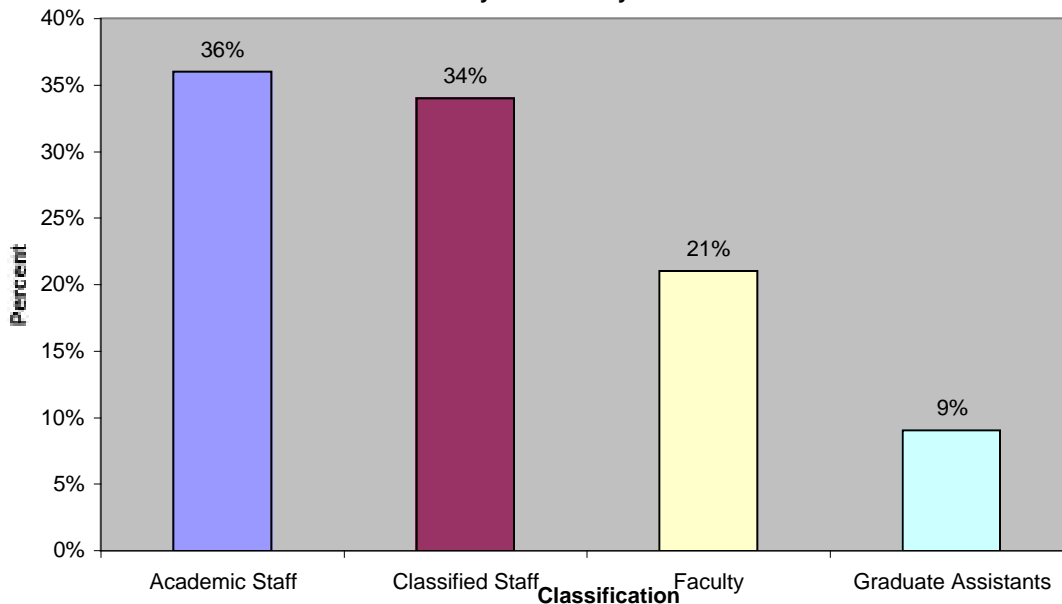
- Approximately 55% are involved in instruction or research

- Participants in instructional governance and policy development as provided by state statute

Functions Performed by UW System Academic Staff by Title



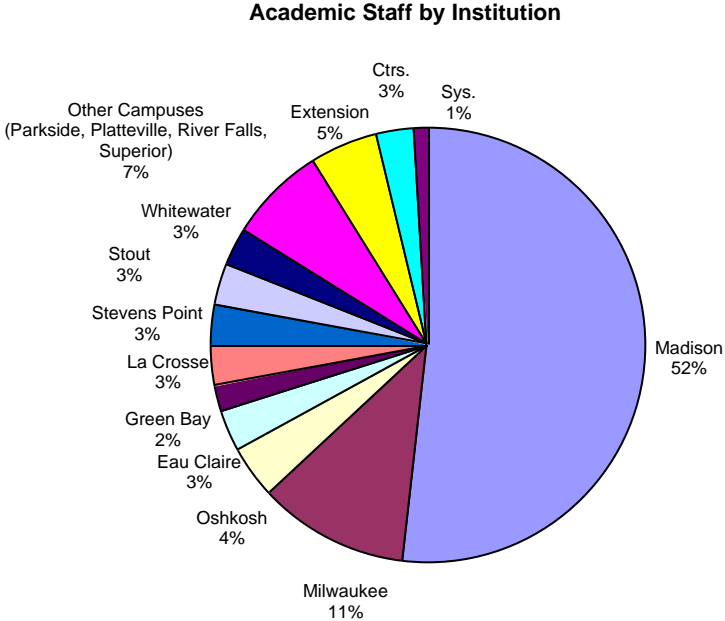
UW System Staff by Classification

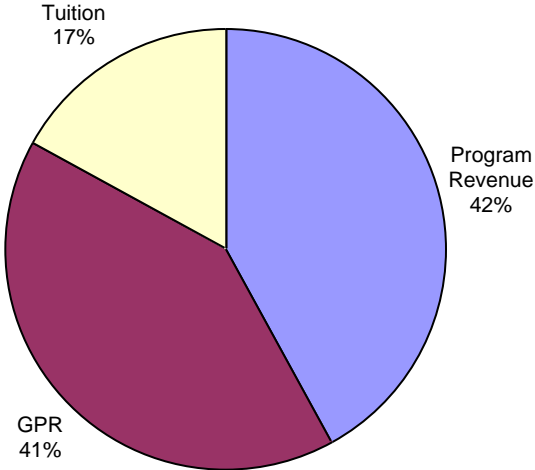

Academic Staff are employed throughout the University System. The Madison and Milwaukee campuses have the largest numbers of academic staff. The Green Bay campus and Extension have the greatest percentage of academic staff among their employees.



The Academic Staff at UW System are funded by a variety of sources. GPR and program revenue, including gifts and grants and federal funds, provide 83% of academic staff compensation.
